BAR-B-Q COOK-OFF RULES & REGULATIONS
SEPTEMBER 4, 2011 —Sunday only

1. teams will consist of CHEF COOK and up to 4 team members
2. teams may enter the grounds on Fri, sept. 2 – (larger pits may set up earlier in a designed area)—get with jimmy---
3. cookers must cook a minimum of 10 lbs. of meat per category entered.
4. the categories to be judged are: **BEEF BRISKET,PORK RIBS,CHICKEN,PINTO BEA NS, CHEF'S CHOICE, ALSO SHOWMANSHIP**
5. meat tag in will begin at 12:00 noon Sat, sept. 3, 2011—*must be raw, thawed, and unseasoned*
6. sept.4th—Sunday---chef's choice: 11:00am, pinto beans: 12:00pm,
7. **chicken: 1:00, ribs: 2:00, brisket: 3:00pm**
8. 20 x 20 space available for each team: bbq pits and campers only (must fit into space)
9. cookers are responsible for all needed equipment and supplies (generators)
10. **THE FAYETTE COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEFT AND ANY TYPE OF DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT OF THE COOKERS (PITS,VEHICLES, CAMPER, ETC.)**
11. fire must be wood or wood substance. No electric or gas fires will be allowed. Only beans will allow a burner. Holes or dug out pits not permitted.
12. the chief cook of each team will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guest. Excessive use of alcohol or fighting will be grounds for disqualification....
13. teams alcohol beverages are limited to team consumption only, and not to be given away to visitors. The fair has organizations selling beer on the grounds as fund raising projects.
14. entry fee--\$50.00 a category or \$90.00 for all three categories (chicken, ribs, beef)
15. entry fee--\$15.00 a category for pinto beans, and chef's choice
16. entries must be received by sept. 3, 2011 before check-in
17. cash awards and trophy's will be given in each category –chicken, pork ribs, beef
18. committeemen reserve the right to make additional regulations as situation warrant. Decisions of the committee chairman are final.
19. ***the fair grounds is not equipped (elect.) for campers. Campers must supply own way of electricity.
20. curfu will be in effect: 12:00 am—each night- no loud music, no parties after 12:00am
21. no vehicles, atv, golf carts allowed in cook-off area.. pets must be on leash at all times in cook-off area
22. **space is limited, so turn in your entry forms early**
23. **no firearms or no glass containers allowed**
